I hope this newsletter finds you doing well. We have had a busy Fall retreat season with retreats, volunteers and meetings. Since the last newsletter the building inspector gave us complete occupancy in the New Boys Dorm (NBD). We have a few minor projects to finish but we are using the building. The Lord's hand of blessing was upon this project. We started the building in October of 2007 and finished it in less than two years with volunteer labor and at a cost of less than \$175,000 and did not have to borrow any money. Thanks to all who helped in this much needed project.

At our October Board meeting I shared with the board that some men have asked about the possibility of building a new kitchen and dining hall. I explained to them that we have just finished a building project and have no immediate plans for a new kitchen. With the blessing of the Board and at no cost to the camp we have contacted an architectural firm to draw up plans for the new kitchen. We have talked and dreamed of this project for many years. We will still keep the current Manna House and use it for small groups and retreats. Please be in prayer for this project. I have included some preliminary drawings. We hope to be able to build a two-story structure with a kitchen and dining hall on the bottom and a chapel and meeting area on the top. If you have been to camp in the past few years you understand why we need a bigger dining hall. If you would like to give to this project please write new kitchen on the memo line of your check. We hope to be able to start the new kitchen this Spring.

Christmas is almost here and I pray that your holiday will be joyful and blessed. I recently watched a video from a missionary in Papua New Guinea. He entered into a village that had never heard the name of Jesus. After several weeks of teaching stories of the Old and New Testament the day came when he taught the story of Jesus' death on the cross and His resurrection. When they heard the truth of the Gospel, most in the village immediately gave their hearts to the Lord and the whole village celebrated. As we enter into this season when we celebrate the birth of our Lord, we should also rejoice and celebrate that He, Jesus, became flesh so that we could be saved from our sins.
